Session One: *The Gilded Age 1890s* – a carriage ride up Fifth Avenue from Washington Square (so beloved by Henry James and Edith Wharton) to the Metropolitan Museum of Art, tracking the relentless move of fashionable society from downtown to uptown.

Session Two: *The Spirit of Achievement* – New York in the 1920s and 1930s, the atmosphere of the brownstones and high society clubs re-created in exquisite detail with digital photography.

Session Three: *Contemporary Street Scenes* – the city as art (includes a walk along the High Line, a meander in Central Park, the reflecting pools at Ground Zero).
